### Question Set 1 – Reading the data table and drilldown

#### Settings:

- Report: Reunification in 12 months (of those reunified)
  - Unit Level: Statewide
1. How many children met the outcome (reunified in 12 months) in January 2012?
  2. What percent were reunified in less than 6 months?
  3. What was the outcome goal?
  4. Of children not meeting the outcome, in February 2012, what was the earliest discharge date?

### Question Set 2 – Report navigation

#### Settings:

- Unit Level: Statewide
1. What percent were the following outcomes met in February 2012?
    - a. Permanency in 12 mos (of those entering care 12 mos ago)
    - b. Adopted in less than 24 months (of those adopted)
    - c. Placement Stability: 2 or fewer placements (of those in care less than 12 months)
      1. What is the link (URL) for this report if you wanted to send it to someone to discuss?

### Question Set 3 – Setting Unit Levels

#### Settings:

- Unit Level: Statewide
1. What percent were the following outcomes met in February 2012?
    - a. Permanency in 12 months (of those entering care 12 mos ago) for Franklin County?
    - b. Adoption in 24 months in Lucas County?
    - c. Placement Stability: 2 or fewer placements (of those in care less than 12 months) in Cuyahoga
    - d. Maintain reunification for 12 months (of those reunified 12 months ago) Statewide

### Question Set 4 – Specifying the Time Period

#### Settings:

- Report: Reunification in 12 months ( of those reunified)
  - Unit Level: Statewide
1. True or False - You have to click on the “Apply Time Period Changes” every time you change the Time Period dates.
  2. What percent of children for whom the Reunification in 12 months outcome was met in January 2011?
  3. How many children were reunified from January 2011 – December 2011?
  4. Would a child that was reunified in 5 days be included in this measure?

## Question Set 5 – Using the Data Display toolbox

### Settings:

- Report: Reunification in 12 months ( of those reunified)
  - Unit Level: Statewide
1. What quarter had the highest percent met for this outcome measure in 2011?
  2. Did state performance in achieving Adoption in 24 months (of those adopted) improve in 2011 over what it was in 2010?
    - a. Did it improve in Franklin County?
  3. How old was the oldest child adopted in 2011 in Franklin County?

## Question Set 6 –Filters

### Settings:

- Report: Reunification in 12 months ( of those reunified)
  - Unit Level: Statewide
1. What percent was the outcome was met for July 2010 – June 2011 for:
    - a. Ages 15 or more
    - b. Female and age 15 or more
    - c. Removal Housing = Applies

## Question Set 7 – Using Views

### Settings:

- Report: Reunification in 12 months (those reunified)
  - Unit Level: Statewide
1. Using the same time period July 2010 – June 2011:
    - a. Was Hamilton County higher or lower than the Statewide average for meeting this outcome?
  2. In crosstab view:
    - a. What age group did Franklin County perform the best with in the July 2010 – June 2011?
  3. In the Trend Annualized report for the month of October 2011?
    - a. How many children was the report based on?
    - b. When did these children discharge to reunification?

### Change Settings:

- Adopted in 12 month target period (of those in care 17+ mos)
  - Franklin county
1. In the Trend: Cumulative View
    - a. As of November 2011, what percent were adopted of this group of children?
    - b. What set of children is this report based?

### Out of Home Care - Caseload Counts

1. Have the number of children in care in Franklin County increased or decreased in the last full quarter?
2. What was the largest age group in care on November 1, 2011 in Franklin County?
3. What county had the third largest number of children in care on November 1, 2011?

### Caseload counts (in care 17+ months)

4. What percent of kids in care 17+ months on October 1, 2011 were in an adoptive placement?

### Level of Care

5. Children in care on September 30, 2011 in Franklin County
  - a. What percent were in a family like setting
  - b. What percent were in institutional care?
6. Children in care on September 30, 2011 in Franklin County
  - a. What is the largest length of stay group
  - b. What percent of 15+ age group has been in care 36+ months?

### Discharge Reason– Franklin County

7. Have adoptions increased statewide from 2010-2011?
8. What age group had the most adoptions in 2011?

### Countdown to Permanency

9. How many children entered care 7 months ago from the “Date data through”?

### Countdown to Adoption

10. What percent of children granted TPR 12 months ago are now adopted?

### Monthly visit

11. How many visit months have children been in care from January 2011 – December 2012 in Lucas County?
12. What percent of those visits were in the child’s residence?

### Report conclusions

13. What percent of child reports were substantiated in 2010?

### Investigation completed within 30 days

14. What percent of child investigations were completed within 30 days in October 2011?

### Permanency in 12 months

15. What percent of children that entered care in the quarter January 2010 – March 2010 achieved permanency in 12 months?
16. Are children that emancipated considered to have achieved permanency?
