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Intake Redesign – Changes to the Intake Screen / Tabs

Overview

This article provides an overview of changes to the **Intake** screen as a result of the **Intake Redesign** that will be implemented in **SACWIS Build 3.06**.

This article also describes the new **Intake Workspace** screen for recording intake **Narrative** comments, and includes instructions for using the **Scripts & Templates** screen in the Intake Workspace.

The changes will include:

- A SACWIS-wide **Recent** button for navigating to the most **Recently Accessed** Cases, Persons, Providers, and Intakes you have viewed or accessed during the current session.
- The **Reporter** tab of the Intake screen will display first upon clicking the **Add Intake** button.
- The **Additional** tab will no longer display; its content will be moved to other tabs.
- The **OHC/Third Party Involvement** tab will be renamed as the **Specialized** tab and will focus on Specialized A/I information. The **Third Party Involvement** fields will be moved to the **Basic** tab.
- A new **ACV/AP Detail** tab will record/display ACV/AP information within the Intake and streamline the gathering of this information.
- A new **Intake Workspace** screen will assist with capturing and displaying Narrative comments. By default, the **Intake Workspace** will display on the left side of the Intake screen when viewing an Intake tab.

Intake Redesign – Changes to the Intake Screen / Tabs

“Recent” Button

A new **Recent** button will display next to the **Home** button on SACWIS screens to help users with navigation. You can click the **Recent** button to display the most **Recently Accessed** Cases, Persons, Providers, and Intakes you have viewed or accessed during the current session.

- Each item in the list is a hyperlink; click a link to access that item again.
- Click the **See More** link at the bottom of the list to display a full list of the last 50 records you have recently viewed or accessed. These items are clickable hyperlinks, and will be sorted by Person, Case, Intake, and Provider.

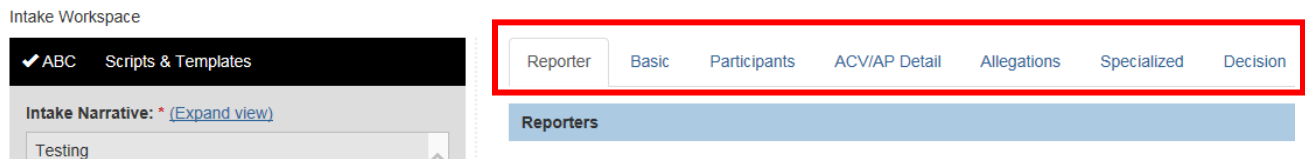
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General Changes to Tabs / Functionality

Intake Screen Tabs

The Intake screen will be divided into the following tabs (as applicable for a specific intake):

- Reporter
- Basic
- Participants
- ACV/AP Detail
- Allegations
- Specialized
- Decision



Major changes at the Tab level include:

- The **Additional** tab will no longer appear in the Intake screen. The information on the **Additional** tab will be moved to other tabs (these changes are noted under the relevant tabs later in this document).
- The **OHC/Third Party Involvement** tab will be renamed as the **Specialized** tab and will focus on Specialized A/I information. The Third Party Involvement fields will be moved to the **Basic** tab.
- A new **ACV/AP Detail** tab will record/display ACV/AP information within the Intake and streamline the gathering of this information.

Initial Tab Display

The Intake screen's **Reporter** tab (not the **Basic** tab) will display first when a Screener clicks the **Add Intake** button. This change will help with the flow of the referral call. You can select another tab, if desired.

AutoSave Functionality

The system will automatically save the intake when you:

- Exit the intake
- OR
- Move from one Intake tab to another Intake tab or another screen. For example, if you are working in an intake and you click a Person hyperlink to look at the Person record, the system will AutoSave the intake for you.

Note: The system may display validation messages requiring you to enter more information before it can save the record and move to another tab/screen.

The system will also AutoSave the **Intake Narrative** you enter. This is discussed later in this article.

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Header Area

The header area of the Intake screen will display additional information, including:

- **Received Date/Time** entry fields – Will display in the header for increased visibility and to aid in backdating the intake, if needed.
- **Method** entry field – Will default to **Phone** but you can select another option from the drop-down list.

- **Indicators** – The following indicator icons will display in the header area of an intake as applicable:
 - **High, Med, or Low** priority – Will display when a **Screening Priority** has been selected on the **Basic** tab, and the intake has not yet been screened.
 - **[R]** – Will display when an intake has been marked as **Restricted**.
 - **Emergency** – Will display when the Intake has been Screened and marked as an Emergency.
 - **Specialized** – Will display when **Yes** is selected for the Specialized A/I question on the Intake tab, and the Intake changes are then applied/ saved.

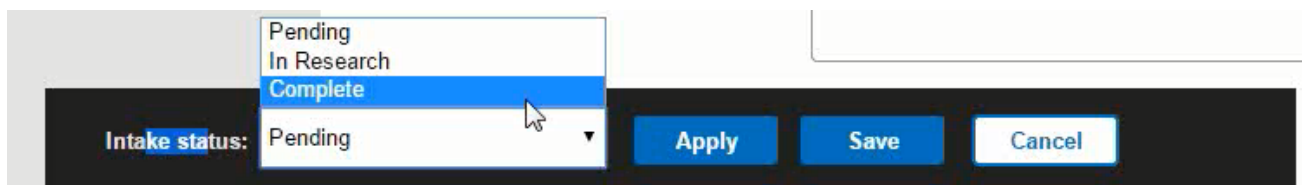
Intake Redesign – Changes to the Intake Screen / Tabs

- **Hazard** – Will display when a **Participant** with an **Environmental Hazard** or **Safety Hazard** on their Person record is added to the Intake, and the Intake changes are then applied/saved.
- **LEP** – Will display when a **Participant** is added whose Person record shows that an interpreter is needed, and the Intake changes are then applied/saved.

Footer Area

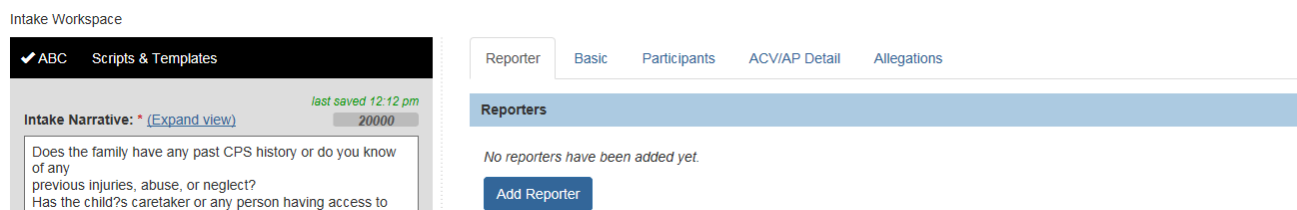
The footer in the Intake screens will be a “sticky footer”. It will always be visible, so you will not have to scroll to the bottom of the screen to click the **Apply** button or **Save** button, etc.

- The **Intake Status** field will also be located in the footer area.



New Intake Workspace Screen

The Intake screen will display a new **Intake Workspace** for Narrative text boxes. This screen will allow users to record and view intake-related narrative and comments in multiple text fields. By default, this screen will display to the left of the Intake tabs as shown below.

Reporter Tab

Key changes include:

- This tab will display first (instead of the **Basic** tab) when the **Add Intake** button is clicked.
- Reporters will be displayed in a list format (instead of a grid).

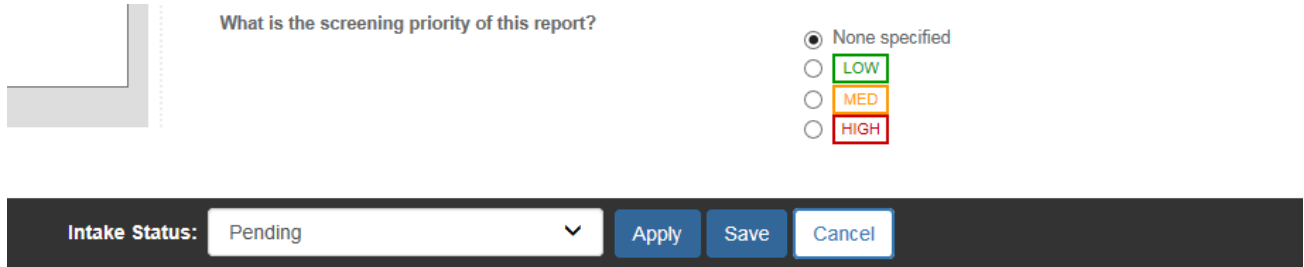

 - The flag will also display in the intake header.

Key changes will include the following:

- Will simplify the process of adding people to the intake.
 - New **Related Persons** functionality will enable you to select Related Person(s) in the same step in which you select a Participant(s).
 - New **Participant Roles** button / functionality will allow you to assign all Participant Roles on one screen, if desired. (You can still assign roles within each Participant Details as well.)
- Will reduce double entry of Person information (in the Intake and in the Person record).
 - New **Original Participant Data / Search Criteria** section will retain information you gathered until the intake has been screened.
 - New **Reconcile** functionality will enable you to reconcile this Person information with the Person information already existing in SACWIS.
- Will display Participants in a list format (not a grid).

Intake Redesign – Changes to the Intake Screen / Tabs

- The **AP** and **ACV** roles for Participants entered after implementation of Build 3.06 will not display as hyperlinks; instead, you can refer to the **ACV/AP Detail** tab of the Intake screen.
 - For historical intakes or intakes that are in progress when Build 3.06 is deployed, the AP and ACV roles will still display as hyperlinks that will display the details screens.
- **Participant Relationships** details screen modified to make selection / display of relationships clearer.
- The **Fatality Status** field will display under each ACV / CSR participant if “Yes” was selected for the new Child Fatality / Near Fatality question on the **Basic** tab. At least one ACV/CSR will be required to have the option **Fatality** or **Near Fatality** selected in this field.

ACV/AP Detail Tab

The new **ACV/AP Detail** tab will be required for **Child Abuse/Neglect, FINS – Stranger Danger, or Dependency** intakes.

Key features/functionality will include the following:

- Will allow you to access the relevant questions right away when recording an intake (without having to first list all of the Participants and assign Roles).
- Questions worded in a more conversational manner to help you ask the reporter for the needed information.
- The top of the screen will list ACVs recorded on the intake (if any), for reference.

- The historical **Allegation Description for Law Enforcement Reporting** section will only display when data exists in the Date or Time of abuse/neglect fields or related Comment field.

This section describes the features and functionality of the new **Intake Workspace** screen for capturing / displaying Narrative comments. By default, the **Intake Workspace** will display on the left side of the Intake screen when you are viewing an Intake tab.

The **Intake Workspace** screen will contain the following text fields:

- **Intake Narrative**
- **Additional Comments about intake (internal use only)**
- **Decision Comments**
- **Post Decision Narrative Amendment**

Overview of Narrative Text Fields

Following is an overview of each Narrative field.

Intake Narrative field – Will allow the Screener to enter narrative comments during the phone call with the reporter. It will also display these narrative comments to the Screener while completing the intake tabs, and to the SDM while reviewing the intake tabs.

- The number of characters allotted for entry in the **Intake Narrative** field will be increased to **20,000 characters**. The character **Counter** will be displayed above the field.

Additional comments about intake (internal use only) field – This field will act as a “sticky note” that will allow the Screener and/or SDM to enter notes to communicate back and forth about the intake. It will display at the bottom of the Intake Workspace screen.

- The Screener and SDM will be able to see each other’s notes and add to them if desired.
- This field will accept up to 500 characters of comments.
- This field will be editable until a Screening Decision is saved, then it will become view-only.
- This field will be internal – it will display only while the intake remains on the Intake Workload; the information will not stay with the intake after it is linked to the case.

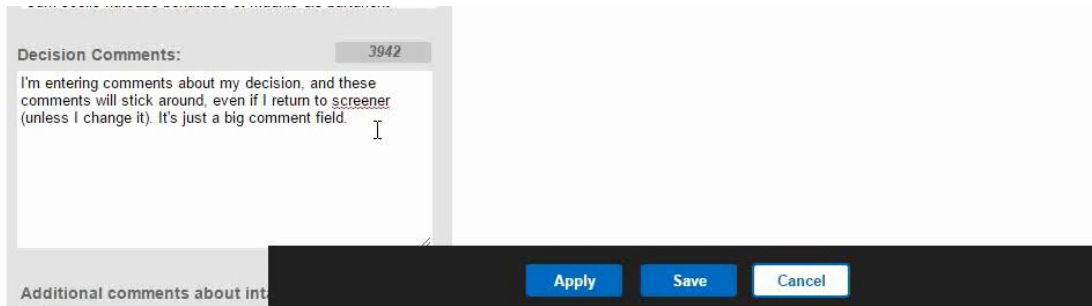

Decision Comments field – This field will allow the SDM to start capturing decision-related comments at any point while reviewing an intake. It will display below the **Narrative** field when an SDM accesses a Completed intake to make a Decision.

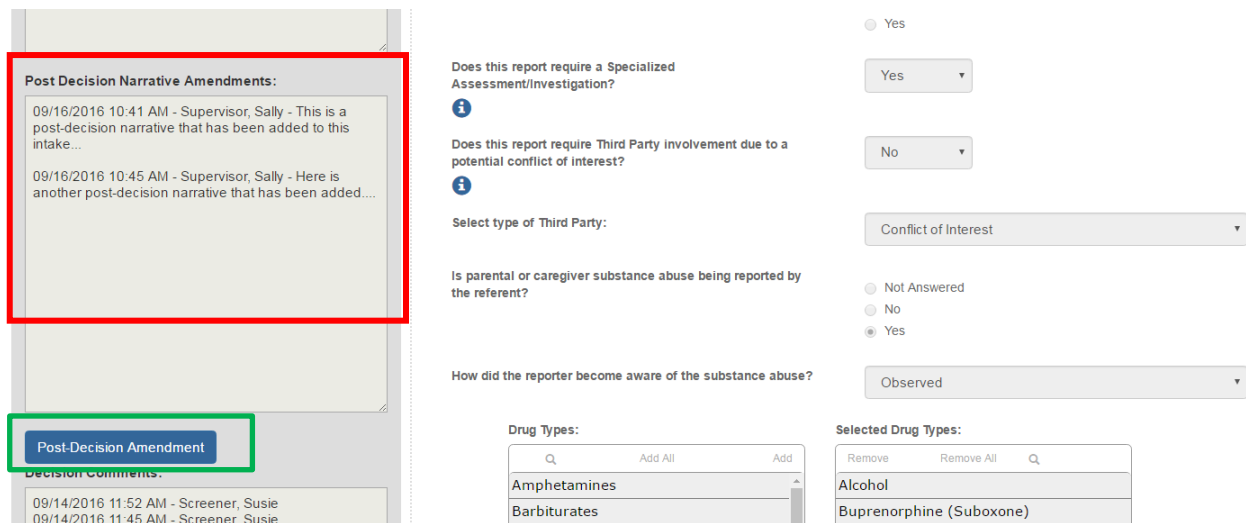

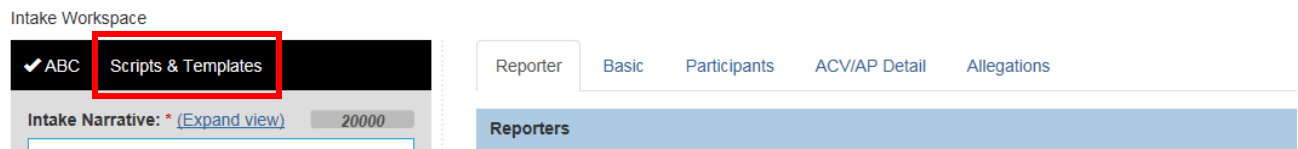
Using the Scripts & Templates Screen

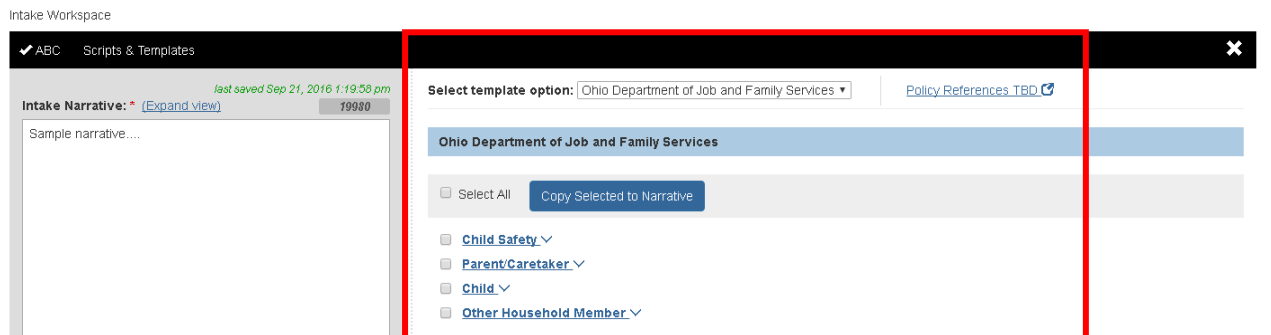
