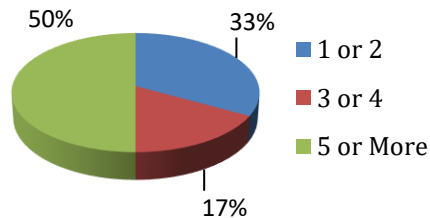

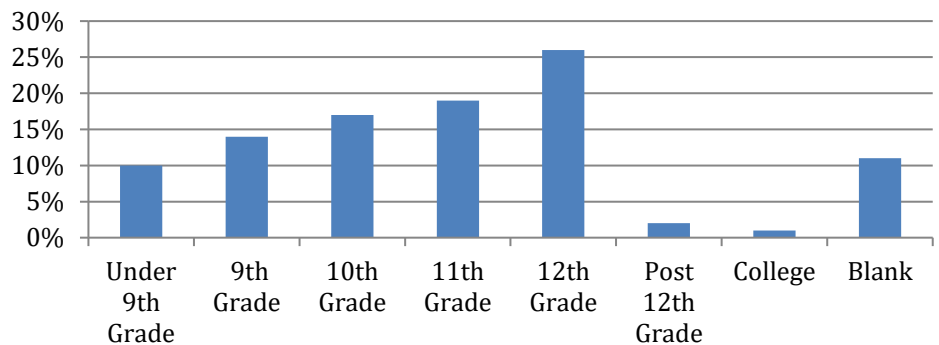

Number of services received (FY15)

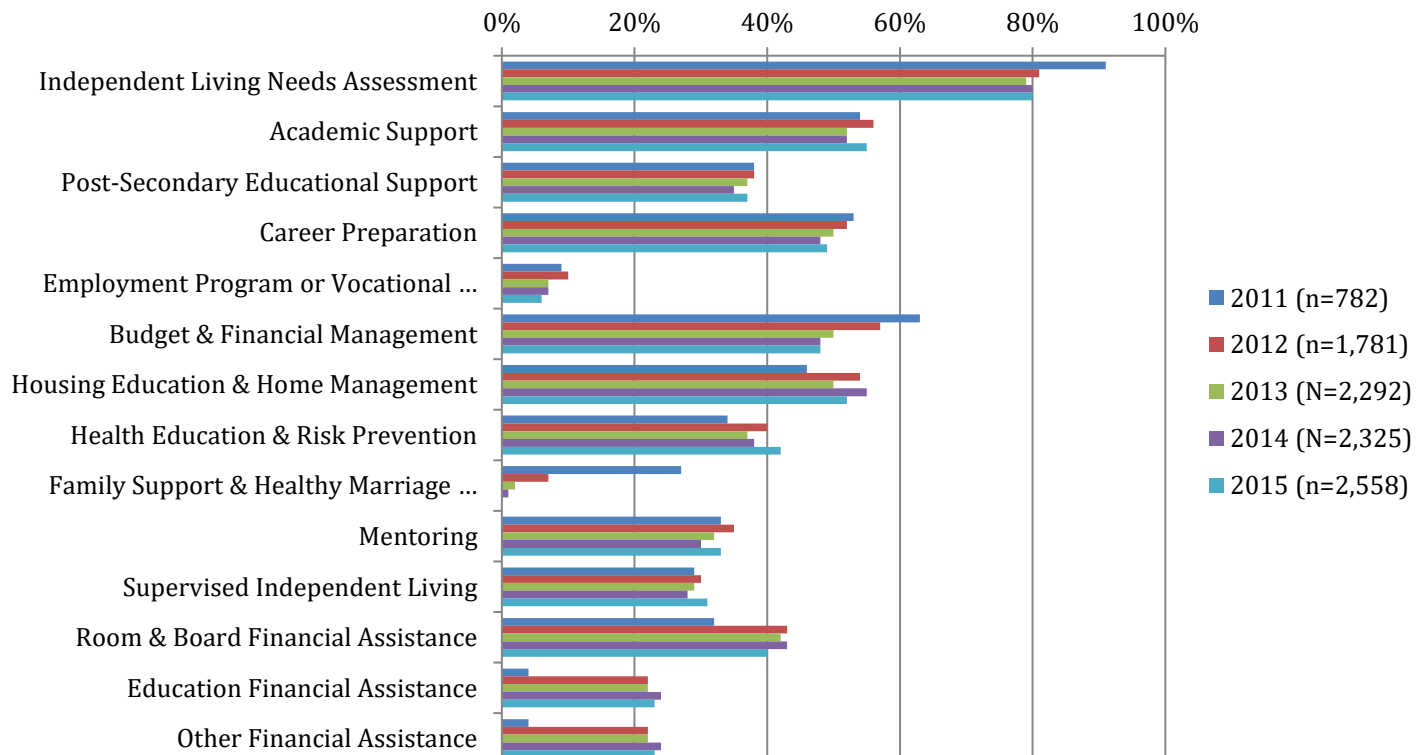


Education level of youth receiving services (FY 15)

Percent of youth receiving each service (of total youth served)



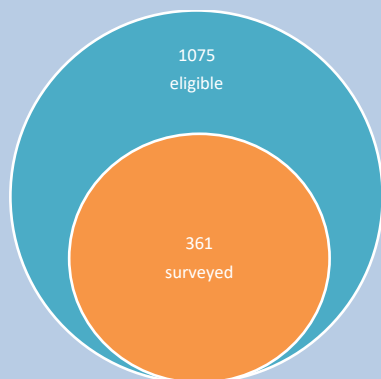

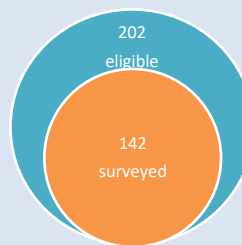
Cohort 1 survey participation, FY 11-15

(17-year-olds in foster care, FY 11)



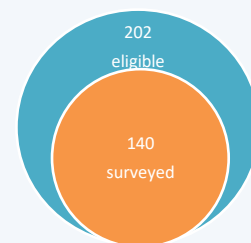
