

The CFIS Project Codes for this are as follows:

Project	Project Code Definition
JFSFS717	Driving and transportation assistance. These costs may be related to obtaining a driver's license, vehicle insurance, driver's education classes and testing fees, practice lessons, practice hours, license fees, roadside assistance, deductible assistance, and assistance in purchasing an automobile. Max \$4,000 per youth ages 15-26.
JFSFP718	Maintenance payments for youth who are not Title IV-E eligible.
JFSFP719	Notifying youth and providing a public awareness campaign about the option to re-enter foster care.
JFSFP720	Supports to prevent youth from aging out of foster care and to facilitate reentry into foster care for youth who previously aged out of foster care.
JFSFP721	Room and Board costs allowable under traditional Chafee.
JFSFP722	Non-room and board costs allowable under traditional Chafee.
JFSFP723	One-time or monthly direct financial assistance to youth/young adults age 18-26 to assist them in meeting their needs during the pandemic.
