- This defect fixes issues related to "Child has an open case with PCSA" as well as fixing issues related to correct Case Category checkbox being checked.
- Changes have been made to the visitation table and visitation report to ensure that Prevention Services/PS AR are incorporated into the visitation email burst so that the report and burst code are aligned.
- The report was updated to exclude agencies with a compliance status of "compliance not determined."
- Two additions have been made to this report:
 - 1. A county column added to indicate the county the family resides and
 - 2. Amount column to display the amount provided, if applicable.
- Several report and functional updates were made to the Master Contract, Contract Details screen,

and Addenda functionality. The screens were updated to reflect the desired functionality.

- When a youth is in a QRTP setting, the ICCA report has been updated to include the “Permanency Team Members Report” as an addendum in the ICCA.
- Needed changes were made to reflect when the report is "in progress" vs. "approved".
- The ENTITY_VIEW table does not appear to be logging person views from RTIS; therefore this defect was created to address this issue.
- The QRTP 60-Day Ruling Due Date Report tracks all youth in a QRTP Placement Setting and displays applicable data pertaining to the 60-Day Ruling Due Date.
- This issue was found while 4.15 was being tested in UAT: When a youth is in a QRTP setting, the ICCA report has been updated to include the “Permanency Team Members Report” as an addendum in the ICCA. SACWIS users now have the ability to include or withhold the Permanency Team Member’s contact information.
- This issue was found while 4.15 was being tested in UAT: Needed report and functional updates were made to the Master Contract, Contract Details screen, and Addenda functionality.
- The Compliant/Non Compliant Agencies will default to 'All'

PROVIDER

- The system now creates a Payment Change Event when the Ruling record (with a QRTP Placement Approved/Disapproved is marked as Created in Error.
- A Payment Change Event is now generated when a QRTP Compliance record is marked as Created in Error.
- A Payment Change Event is now generated when a QRTP Compliance record is backdated.
- This defect ensures that SACWIS updates payments when the date of Compliance of a QRTP is changed.
- A Payment Change Event is now generated when a QRTP Compliance record is changed to a date further in the future than was previously entered.
- A Payment Change Event is now created when changes occur in a linked Prevention Services Approval record.
- The system now modifies reimbursability records accordingly when an agency becomes QRTP Compliant or falls out of QRTP Compliance.
- Upon the child's Adoption record being sealed/secured in SACWIS, the system now copies multiple managed care spans, if applicable.
- Payment Change Event created by Provider License Maintenance utility has been modified to set Process Date to null instead of current system date.
- Prevention Services Approval record can now be edited even if it is an end-dated record.
- Provider Match was not functioning for Independent Living Service Category on the Placement Services tab of the RTIS Discharge Plan. This has been corrected.
- As a result of the Prevention Services initiative, users are no longer able to delete a service if it's linked to a work item, including an invoice.
- As a result of Prevention Services initiative, users are no longer able to delete a Prevention Services Approval record that is linked to a work item, including an invoice.
- When an RTIS Discharge Plan Service was in Needed status, the system was bringing back a linked Closed, Home Provider ID which was not entered data. This no longer appears on the discharge plan or discharge plan report.
- Placement services now display the following modified data for Non-end dated Treatment Records, Medications and Diagnosed Conditions and any end-dated records which were created in the time frame of placement begin date minus 90 days to current system date.
- Users with the RTIS Supervisor User Group now have the following options to choose from: “Approved - Final”, “Declined for re-work” and “Routed” and “Re-routed”.
- The spelling error on the Aftercare Services tab of the Discharge Plan (the word Additional) has been corrected.
