

## AFCARS 2020 Elements 72-105 Child and Family Circumstances at Removal SACWIS Removal Reasons Guide

AFCARS 2020 Elements 72-105 Child and Family Circumstances at Removal correspond to the Removal Reasons on the Initial Removal SACWIS page. The chart below details the changes to both available Removal Reason values in SACWIS and the Removal Reasons to be added and how those values will map to the revised Child and Family Circumstances at Removal values in AFCARS 2020.

### Abandonment/Relinquishment/Safe Haven Grid

Removal Reason	Safe Haven (Y/N)	When to Use Value
Abandonment (Parents Unknown – Not Safe Haven)	N	When the child has been left alone or with others and the P/G/C identity is unknown and cannot be ascertained
Abandonment (Parent Known - Not Safe Haven)	N	The parent, legal guardian or caretaker did not or has not returned for the child or made his or her whereabouts known.
Custody Relinquishment-Medical Treatment	N	The child and/or child's family has inadequate resources to access the necessary medical services outside of the child's out-of-home care placement. <b>This value should only be selected when the custody is being relinquished solely for the purpose of affording needed treatment for the child.</b>
Custody Relinquishment-Mental Health Treatment	N	The child and/or child's family has inadequate resources to access the necessary mental health services outside of the child's out-of-home care placement. <b>This value should only be selected when the custody is being relinquished solely for the purpose of affording needed treatment for the child.</b>

Custody Relinquishment for Adoption - (Not Safe Haven)	N	The child's parent has voluntarily relinquished the child by assigning the physical and legal custody of the child to the title IV-E agency, in writing, for the purpose of having the child adopted.
Safe Haven	Y	The child's parent has voluntarily relinquished the child by assigning the physical and legal custody of the child to the title IV-E agency, in writing, for the purpose of having the child adopted. This includes a child left at a "safe haven" as defined by the title IV-E agency.

## **Notes/Justifications for Circumstances at Removal**

### **Elements 72 & 73**

- For runaway we currently have the SACWIS checkbox with AWOL at Agency Custody. New functionality will ensure that if AWOL at Agency Custody checkbox is selected on Initial Removal, the user will be presented with additional selections that will be
  - Child is considered a runaway
  - Child whereabouts unknown but not considered a runaway
  
- Existing AFCARS code that brings in records for
  - AWOL providers created by PCSAs
  - Placement leaves
