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Recording Child Fatalities and Near Fatalities

Overview

This article describes the **Child Fatality** and **Near Fatality** functionality within the Ohio SACWIS system. This functionality will help to capture accurate information about child fatalities and near fatalities.

Child Fatality / Near Fatality Fields Added to Intake

Tabs listed are the **Basic** tab, **Participants** tab, and **Allegations** tab of the **Intake** as described below.

The Intake **Basic** tab will display this question: **Does this report allege a child fatality or near fatality?**

The values for the question will be displayed as three radio buttons:

- **No Value Selected** – this is the default value.
- **No**
- **Yes** – if this answer is selected, additional child fatality questions will populate on the **Participants** and **Allegations** tabs.



Checkbox on Allegations Tab

The **Intake Allegations** tab will display a new checkbox: **Pertinent to the Fatality/Near Fatality**. This checkbox will display when the **value Fatality** or **Near Fatality** has been selected in the **Fatality Status** field on the Intake **Participants** tab for the ACV/CSR on the allegation.

The checkbox will display near the **Reported By** field for each allegation.

The user will be **Required** to select **at least one checkbox** in order to complete the intake.

Recording Child Fatalities and Near Fatalities

Related Business Rules

The following related business rules will be implemented:

- When a **CA/N intake** has been flagged as a **Fatality or Near Fatality**, AND **at least one Participant** has a **Fatality Status of Fatality**, then the **Reason for not screening in AR** field will automatically populate with **Mandatory – Report involves a suspicious child fatality or homicide** when **Screened In** is selected as the **Screening Decision**. This drop-down will stay enabled, and the user will have the ability to change the option.
- When a **CA/N intake** has been flagged as a **Fatality or Near Fatality**, AND no **Participant** has a **Fatality Status of Fatality** then the **Reason for not screening in AR** field will automatically populate with **Mandatory – Report alleges serious injury or harm to a child** when **Screened In** is selected as the **Screening Decision**. This drop-down will stay enabled, and the user will have the ability to change the option.
- When a screening decision is saved for a **CA/N intake** that has been flagged as a **Fatality or Near Fatality**, a notification email is sent to the **Technical Assistance Managers** and the Agency System Administrator(s) for the agency on the intake.

Child Fatality NCANDS Question Added to Screening Decision

The **Intake Decision** tab will display a new question: **You have chosen to Screen Out a CA/N report concerning a Child Fatality. Should this Child Fatality be Reported to NCANDS?**

This question will display when:

- The intake is a **CA/N** or **FINS-Stranger Danger intake**,
- AND
- The **Fatality Status** of any intake Participant is **Fatality**,
- AND
- The **Screening Decision** selected is **Screened Out**.

Recording Child Fatalities and Near Fatalities

This question is intended to ensure that all abuse/neglect fatalities are accurately reported to NCANDS in the event that the decision is made to screen out such a report.

National Child Abuse and Neglect Data System (NCANDS) defines “Child fatality” as the death of a child caused by an injury resulting from abuse or neglect or where abuse or neglect was a contributing factor.

Child Fatality / Near Fatality Work Item

A new **Work Item** will be added on the **Case** for recording **Child Fatalities and Near Fatalities**. This new work item is Child-specific and can be entered on both **Open and Closed** cases. In addition:

- **Linking** the pertinent Intake will automatically populate fields on the work item, creating less work for the user.
- The work item must be routed and **Approved** by a supervisor.

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- The work item must be completed and approved **within five (5) business days** of receiving the information.
- The work item can be **Amended** after approval to show additional information received or a change in Fatality / Near Fatality status for the child.

The case **Navigation** menu will display a new **Child Fatality/Near Fatality** hyperlink.

Creating a Child Fatality / Near Fatality Record

To add a new **Fatality** or **Near Fatality** record, complete the following steps.

1. Navigate to the appropriate **Case**.
2. Click the **Child Fatality/Near Fatality** link in the **Navigation** menu.

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7. The **Intake Information** section displays any linked intake(s). If you wish to link an intake, click the **Link Intake** button to display the **Available Intakes** screen. Then return to Step 5 above. (Optional)
8. If there are no linked intake(s) for this work item, click the appropriate radio button for the question, **Does this report allege a child fatality or near fatality?** (Required)
 - If there are linked intake(s), this field is populated with the **Fatality Status** of the child on the linked intake(s) and is disabled.
 - If there are multiple Fatality Statuses for the child (i.e., both **Fatality** and **Near Fatality**), the **Child Fatality** option is selected.

9. If the **Child Fatality** radio button is selected in Step 8, the following field is enabled: **Has Law Enforcement, Medical or PCSA personnel suspected the child's death was a result of child abuse/neglect.** Select the appropriate value from the drop- down list.
10. The **Law Enforcement Jurisdiction** field will pull the jurisdiction from the Allegation Setting address if data exists. Otherwise, you may enter this information. (Optional)

- The **Child Information** section of this screen displays information from the **Person Profile** of the selected **Child**.

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- The **Alleged Perpetrator Information** section displays **Participant(s)** from the linked intake(s) with a role of **Alleged Perpetrator** in an allegation(s) where the Alleged Child Victim is the focus Child in the **Child Fatality/Near Fatality Record**.

 - b. If you selected the **Alleged Perpetrator** radio button and there are multiple Alleged Perpetrators, select the appropriate name in the **Available Alleged Perpetrators** drop-down list to further filter the list. (Optional)

Recording Child Fatalities and Near Fatalities

The screen will display an **Information Icon** () beside the **Severity of Harm** field. Hovering your mouse pointer over the Information icon will display the following explanation:

A ‘near fatality’ is an act of abuse of neglect that, as certified by a physician, places the child in serious or critical condition. ‘Child fatality’ is the death of a child caused by injury resulting from abuse or neglect where abuse or neglect was a contributing factor.


Related Business Rules

- If **Child Fatality or Near Fatality** is selected in the **Severity of Harm** field, then the value **Not Applicable** cannot be selected in the **Harm Descriptions** field.

Child Fatality / Near Fatality Indicator Added to Case Intake List

The **Status** column of the **Case Episode Intake List** will display a **Fatality or Near Fatality** indicator for:

- Any intake which has been flagged as a **Fatality or Near Fatality**, AND/OR
- Any intake which has a **Severity of Harm** value of **Fatality or Near Fatality** in the **Disposition**.
