
## FFY 2016B Outcomes Participation Compliance

- We just completed the 19 year old follow up sample population surveys for Cohort 2.
- The Federal benchmark for Outcomes Participation Compliance is 60% for the 19 year old and 21 year old populations.
- Ohio's Outcomes Participation Compliance for this population was 70.15% for 2016B

#### Ohio's NYTD Compliance

- In order to ensure that Ohio maintains compliance as we move forward, it is recommended that agencies attempt to keep in contact with the 19 year old youth from the 2016B population so they can be surveyed at 21 years old.






#### What is NYTD?

- There are many reporting components to NYTD
  - Data such as services, placement, and demographic information
  - NYTD Survey
- Authorized by the John H. Chafee Foster Care Independence Act P.L. 106-109
- A cohort study of youth in foster care where a baseline is created once the 17 year old surveys are completed.
- States have the option of sampling the 17 year old baseline population. Ohio has elected to sample for Cohorts 1 and 2.
- The cohort then becomes the 17 year old sample youth who we then follow up with at 19 and 21 years old.
- Ohio is required to report NYTD data to the Administration for Children and Families for every Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) Period
  - October 1 to March 31
  - April 1 to September 30

#### COHORT 3 SURVEYS FFY 2017 October 1, 2016 – September 30, 2017

Youth who turn 17 while in care are surveyed.
 Youth must be surveyed on his/her 17th birthday or within 45 days after his/her 17th birthday.


#### Things to Watch For

- If youth is surveyed before his/her 17th birthday or more than 45 days following his/her 17th birthday, the survey is <u>invalid and no longer</u> in the Cohort.
- Youth can come into care throughout the FFY Period affecting NYTD outcomes.
- The statistical report can change when youth come in or leave care



#### Generating the NYTD Account in SACWIS


- In order to generate the NYTD Account, the youth's Independent Living Plan must first be created.
- The NYTD Account can be generated when the Independent Living plan is in Pending, Active, or Closed status.

#### Independent Living Plans in SACWIS







#### Independent Living Plans in SACWIS










#### Generating the NYTD Survey Information Letter





Generate the NYTD Survey Information Letter to give to the youth. This letter displays all of the log in information and the link to the NYTD Survey.




- The youth should log onto the survey and complete the survey.



#### **NYTD Survey Outcomes**

- By selecting the Outcome Reason of <u>Runaway/Missing</u>, you are verifying that the youth was runaway/missing during the entire data collection period.
- By selecting the Outcome Reason of <u>Incarcerated</u>, you are verifying that the youth is incarcerated during the entire data collection period.
- By selecting the Outcome Reason of <u>Incapacitated</u>, you are verifying that the youth is not able to complete the survey due to a permanent or temporary mental or physical condition.
